Course Description

Reading Seminar is a class that uses the Wilson Reading System, a researched based reading and writing program. Wilson teaches the structure of words in the English language using an organized and sequential system with twelve steps. The program teaches specific strategies for decoding, spelling, comprehension and oral expressive language development.

Materials

Students will be given a Wilson notebook and a reading binder. These materials will stay in class and students are expected to maintain them.

Daily- students will need pencils, notebook paper and fully charged IPAD.

Classroom Expectations

Students are expected to be respectful of others, participate in class activities and complete independent work. It is the student's responsibility to make-up work when they are absent. Because of the small group nature of the class, most behaviors can be addressed in class with a reminder or redirection. Serious behaviors will result in: private conferences with student, phone call to parents and office referral.
